Q: My daughter has not received her Semester 1 report for 2020.

A: [Submit Semester 1 and Semester 2 reports for 2019](#)

Q: My daughter has an Australian birth certificate, is that sufficient proof of residency?

A: [If both parents were born overseas we require proof of permanent resident visa either via your daughter's Australian passport or citizenship](#)

Q: Should I include any other additional documents to support my application?

A: [No. The documents required are listed in the 'Instructions for Applicants' form.](#)

Q: Where will my daughter sit the Higher Ability Selection Test?

A: [The selection test will be held at St George Girls High School on Saturday 8th August at 9:30 am. If you select three schools from the following list, whichever school is the first choice is where your daughter will sit the test.](#)

Q: Does St George Girls High School have an application fee ?

[If St George Girls High School is your first preference, the application fee is \\$100.](#)

[If St George Girls High School is your second or third preference and your first preference is from the list above, the application fee is \\$30.](#)

[If your first preference of school is not listed above you will need to pay \\$100 to the first school selected from the list. Please note payments must be made direct to the school you are applying for.](#)

Q: Does one application cover all schools?

A: [No, you must lodge an application with each school. Please refer to each school's website for specific information that may be required.](#)

Q: How many vacancies will you have?

A: [In Years 8-10 vacancies are dependent on current students moving to another school and typically they will advise us sometime in Term 4 through to Term 1 next year.](#)
